Starting with a new childcare provider can be a scary time for both parents and children! Please be assured we have done this many times before and we are here to support both you and your child. (We have attached testimonies from parents from our Child minding setting).

There are lots of ways you can get involved in your child's time here at Jubilee Childcare and work with us to support your child's learning and development. The EYFS (which is a statutory framework) tells us that partnership working is the best way to make sure all children make the good progress and reach their full potential in their lives.

The EYFS puts the responsibility on the setting to engage parents in their child's learning and development experience. This was introduced in September 2012 and was previously known as the Foundations Stage Profile.

Although the fundamental principles of Early years practice hasn't changed the layout and wording is quite different. We continue to build our knowledge and become accustomed to the new layout.

The curriculum is split into 3 prime areas and 4 specific areas. The Prime areas are:-

1. Personal, Social and Emotional
2. Communications and Language
3. Physical

The 4 Specific areas are:

1. Literacy
2. Maths
3. Understanding the World
4. Expressive Arts.

Over the next few weeks we will discuss how we regularly communicate with you about your child's progress, share information with you about your child's learning and development, give you ideas for activities your child might enjoy at home, share our planning with you and let you know about how your child spends their time with us.
